



We are happy to have you as a new or returning member of our canoe club and hope you enjoy your season with us. Our club history is long and eventful, and we work towards providing a respectful, healthy and happy environment for each member, paddler, family and our community. Here's what to do now that you have the 2020 season packet.

1. Registration Days: **Saturday, 3/7/20, Sunday, 3/8/20, Saturday, 3/21/20 and Sunday, 3/22/20. 10:00am-2:00pm** Kailua Canoe Club halau (across from Buzz's Steak House). Paddlers registering after these dates can slide **COMPLETE** paperwork & payment into the slot in the metal locked dropbox **INSIDE** the halau in the corner where the hose bib is located.

Come to registration with all paperwork & payment. All paperwork needed before getting in a canoe. We need:

- ✓ Kailua Canoe Club Registration Form
- ✓ 2020 HCRA Waiver
- ✓ A copy of your ID (birth certificate, drivers license, passport, State ID, military ID, etc...no school IDs). I have IDs on file for many paddlers who paddled with KCC the past couple of years.
- ✓ A photo of fabulous YOU! We'll have a camera available at registration or photos can be emailed to the email below. (No hats, no sunglasses, no glasses unless you race with them).
- ✓ Payment payable to Kailua Canoe Club (check, cash, Visa/Mastercard – 3% transaction fee for cards)

2. The email you provide at registration will be entered into our club email database. This will provide you with information about current and upcoming KCC events. If you find you are not receiving emails from the club, visit www.kailuacanoecub.com and click the "Sign Up For Emails" on the home page. Our website has a lot of information about our club so take a look around it and learn more about your canoe club.

3. **Check the bulletin board regularly.** The registration committee posts a list of missing or incomplete paperwork weekly as it is detected, so check the list even if you think you've turned everything in. There's also more great information on the bulletin board about practice dates/times, the club and activities, lost and found items, race information, etc.

4. All paddlers will need to bring their own paddle to practice. New paddlers should check with their coaches before purchasing and may have access to practice paddles for the first practices only. Paddlers who end up steering will need a different steering paddle. Paddles can be purchased at Island Paddler on Kapahulu in Honolulu (the Kailua store is temporarily closed) 737-4854, at TwoGood Kayaks, through Uncle Bobby Puakea (247-1428) or through Kalai Handley (375-6694).

5. If your child in the 12 & Under through 18 & Under divisions and unable to paddle because of financial reasons, please email kccregistrar@gmail.com for scholarship information or download the scholarship application from the KCC website on the Join page. 10 & Under paddlers are not eligible due to their already reduced dues).

6. Practice days/times are listed on the bulletin board. Dates and times may be subject to change without notice so check it regularly.

**Hawaiian Canoe Racing Association Insurance Program
Adult and Minor Waiver and Release of Liability
January 1, 2020 to December 31, 2020**

Canoe Club: _____

In consideration of being allowed to participate in any way in the Hawaiian Canoe Racing Association and its member organizations' athletics/sports programs, and related events and activities, the undersigned:

1. Agree that prior to participating, they each will inspect the facilities and equipment to be used, and if they believe anything is unsafe, they will immediately advise their coach or supervisor of such condition(s) and refuse to participate.
2. Acknowledge and fully understand that each participant will be engaging in activities that involve risk of serious injury, including permanent disability and death, and severe social and economic losses which might result not only from their own actions, inactions or negligence, but the action, inaction or negligence of others, the rules of play, or the condition of the premises or of any equipment used. Further, that there may be other risks not known to us or not reasonably foreseeable at this time.
3. Assume all the foregoing risks and accept personal responsibility for the damages following such injury, permanent disability or death.
4. Release, waive, discharge and covenant not to sue the Hawaiian Canoe Racing Association, its member associations, its affiliated clubs, their respective administrators, directors, agents, coaches, and other volunteers or employees of the organization, other participants, sponsoring agencies, sponsors, advertisers, and if applicable, owners and leasers of premises used to conduct the event, all of which are hereinafter referred to as "releasees", from demands, losses or damages on account of injury, including death or damage to property, caused or alleged to be caused in whole or in part by the negligence of the releasee or otherwise.

The undersigned custodial parent or legal guardian acknowledges that he/she is also signing this release on behalf of the minor participant, that he/she is waiving certain rights on behalf of the minor participant that the minor participant otherwise may have and that the minor participant shall be bound by all of the terms of this release. By signing this waiver and release without a parent's or guardian's signature, the participant represents he/she is at least 18 years of age, or, if signing as the parent or guardian of the participant, signer represents they are the custodial parent or legal guardian of the minor participant.

THE UNDERSIGNED HAVING READ THE ABOVE WAIVER AND RELEASE, UNDERSTAND THAT THEY HAVE GIVEN UP SUBSTANTIAL RIGHTS BY SIGNING IT AND SIGN IT VOLUNTARILY.
